

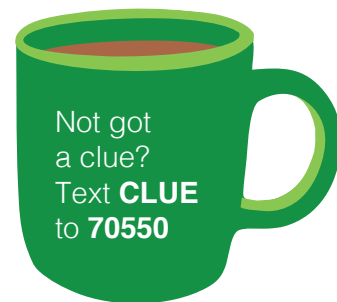
# BRAIN TEA-SER CHALLENGE
